Ecco il motivo di questo libro, nato per spiegare cosa è davvero la domotica e che cosa si intende oggi per “casa intelligente”. Il tutto in una prospettiva “applicata”, cioè concreta. Una prospettiva in grado di dare indicazioni pratiche a tutti coloro che, coinvolti nel processo edilizio, dagli architetti agli installatori, non possono oggi prescindere dall’aspetto più tecnologico della nuova casa 3.0.
